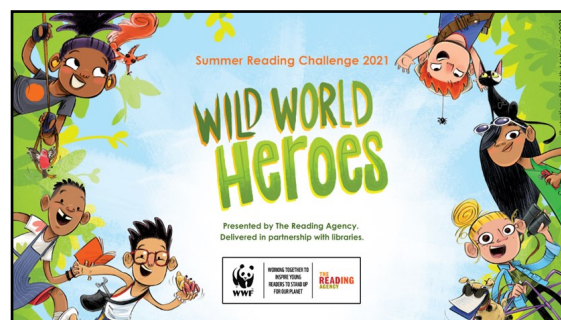
Book Amnesty

The BIG Question

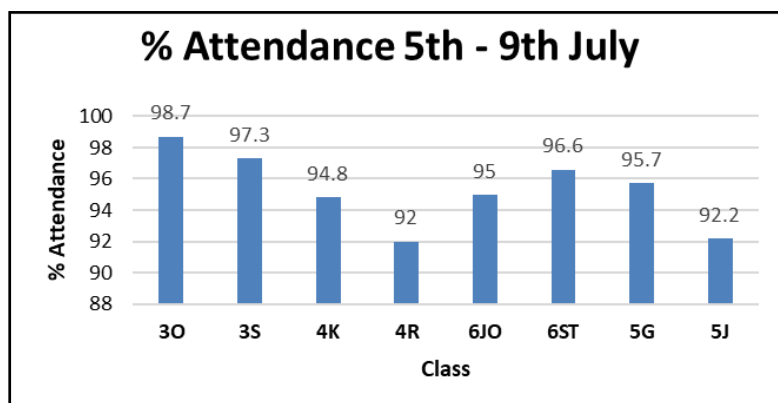
Next week's BIG Question is: Is there anything that can last forever?
