The children have been working hard drawing self-portraits to feature on a tea towel for The Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

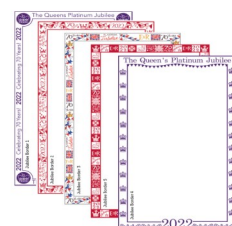

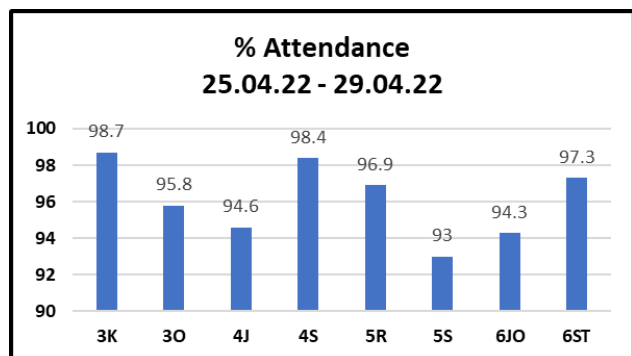
