Hillingdon Archery Club

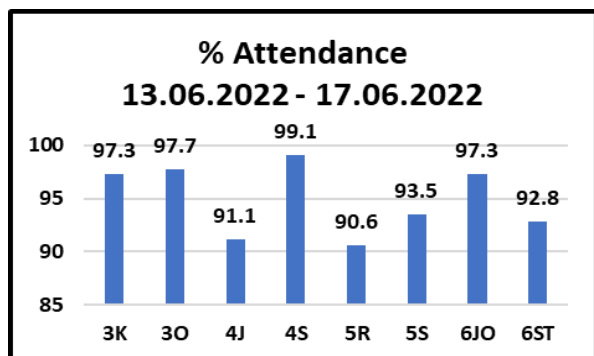
